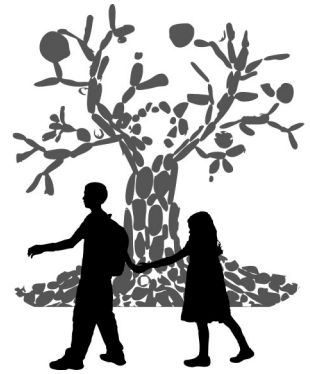

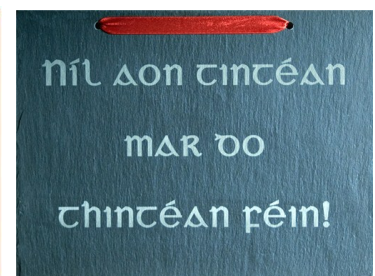

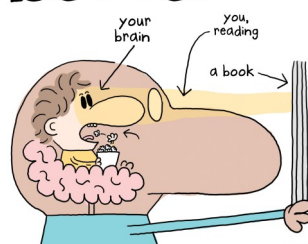
School Gardens: Any other parents interested in helping out with gardening/vegetable growing are asked to leave their name and contact number with the school office or text Carol on 087 211 7250.
