

In 2016, Gorey Educate Together NS was one of the schools that piloted DCU's *All Together Now* programme (anti-bullying of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Trans young people) - a programme that was subsequently successfully launched into primary schools across Ireland.

These lessons were taught to our current 5th and 6th classes earlier this year, in tandem with the *Stay Safe* programme.
