The children on our School Council invite you to attend our School Disco. Optional dress-up theme, as voted for by 1st—6th classes: **Halloween**!

Times: Infants, 1st & 2nd classes: 6pm-7.30pm; older classes 7.30pm-9pm. (Families with siblings: come at the time that will work best for you, but get older children to sit out for the younger section and vice versa.)

New: this disco will also include '<u>sensory</u> <u>friendly</u>' slots from 7.10pm-7.30pm and 7.30pm-7.50pm, when the music volume will be turned down much lower than usual.

Entry: $\[mathcal{e}2\]$ per child; pre-schoolers free; maximum family charge $\[mathcal{e}5\]$. Also, tuck shop open on the night. (Children to bring coins with them, rather than notes.)

Please note that this event is for current Gorey Educate Together families only - we wouldn't have room for cousins, neighbours, past pupils, etc.

ELECTION OF PARENT NOMINEES TO THE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT

The current term of the school's Board of Management will expire on 30/11/2023 and a new Board will take up office on 01/12/2023. Two parents of children enrolled in the school (one being a mother and the other a father) must be elected by the general body of parents of children enrolled in the school.

A meeting will be held at the school at 7.30pm on Wednesday 18th October 2023.

At this meeting:-

Nominations will be sought from parents for persons to stand for election as parent nominees on the Board.

A ballot will be held at the meeting to elect the nominees. If there is only one nominee for either panel, the nominees shall be deemed to be elected. If more than one nomination is received for either of the panels, a secret ballot shall be held at the meeting.

A panel will also be established from which vacancies arising during the 4-year term of the Board may be filled.
