The SALT Programme is a **conflict resolution** initiative designed to equip children with the skills to handle conflicts effectively. It is aligned with the SPHE curriculum and focuses on building children's capacity to negotiate and resolve conflicts. The programme includes the SALT steps: Stop, Ask, Listen, Talk, which are used to address conflicts discreetly and constructively.
